PROCESS

- Submit this document to your State Youth Coordinator (SYC).
 - Exceptions will not be considered before March 15th.
 - All forms must be submitted at least two (2) weeks prior to the event for which the exception is being requested.
- The SYC will consult their Regional Youth Director (RYD) and, if necessary, the Manager of Youth Competition to determine whether an exception will be granted.
- Please allow 1-2 weeks for response time. An affirmative response is required in order to participate in the event in question. Responses are valid for the current year only.
